The Laws and the Rules of the Board constitute the regulations governing the practice of engineering and land surveying in the State of Louisiana Revised Statutes 37:681 through 37:703, which we commonly refer to as "the Licensure Law" or "the Law".

Professional ethics concerns the standard of professional conduct and responsibility required of a professional engineer. Rule 3105(B)(1) reads: During each biennial licensure renewal period beginning before January 1, 2017, at least one PDH shall be in professional ethics. A.(1) The Louisiana Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board is hereby created, whose duty it shall be to administer the provisions of this Chapter. The board shall be licensed professional engineers, and two of whom shall be licensed professional land surveyors.
